Frequently Asked Presenter Questions

When will I be notified of my presentation day and time?

Presenters will be notified of their presentation day, time and location in February 2026.

Why does NCA require registration for the conference?

NCA aims to deliver a high-quality educational experience. Requiring registration greatly minimizes the number of workshop cancellations. We understand that this is an investment for conference presenters, and thus we are also committed to promoting all of our conference presenters to maximize exposure.

Why do I need to upload my presentation by March 6, 2026?

Presenters will need to upload their presentation and any necessary handouts they wish to upload into the attendee library by March 6, 2026. We review every presentation submitted. Thus, your presentation needs to be ready in advance. Revisions may be requested to meet NCNC presentation standards. Once approved, your presentation will be uploaded and available on a computer for the day of your presentation.

May I submit my presentation for early review?

Yes, you may submit your presentation and any necessary handouts you wish to upload into the attendee library as early as February 1, 2026. Presentations are reviewed in the order in which they are received. If you submit early, our team will review and provide feedback within 3-4 business days.

Will any of my conference-related expenses be covered?

Presentations are considered professional contributions to the child nutrition community. Therefore, NCA does not pay an honorarium for speakers or any related travel expenses, including conference registration, airfare, hotel or meals.



Do I need to bring my own computer to the conference?
