PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, championed by Eleanor Roosevelt in 1948, recognizes children's right to nutrition, and caring for them must be our priority; and
- WHEREAS, since its inception in 1968, the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) has provided a strong foundation of nutrition and health for children and adults, benefiting our state's well-being; and
- WHEREAS, CACFP ensures children receive nutritious meals during key developmental years while fostering lifelong healthy eating habits that support emotional, mental, and physical health; and
- WHEREAS, we commend the dedication of child and adult care providers, nutrition educators, and program specialists who work tirelessly to ensure CACFP's success; and
- WHEREAS, the CACFP community remains committed to promoting nutrition security and quality care in communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Braun, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim March 16-22, 2025 as
