## CHILD NUTRITION VIRTUAL SUMMIT

### Why is it important to attend the virtual summit?

### How much does it cost to attend?

Registration for the virtual summit is \$149.00 per person.

### Will there be Spanish translation?

No, there is no Spanish translation provided.

### How were the sessions selected?

The lineup of sessions includes some of the most popular sessions that were to be offered at the 2020 National Child Nutrition Conference scheduled for this past April. Workshops were selected from many of the tracks offered at the annual conference to address the training needs of the diverse group of attendees and child nutrition advocates.

### How do I join sessions?

To join sessions, internet access will be needed and Zoom software will need to be allowed to “run” from your device. Each session will begin at the assigned time based on Eastern Standard Time. When you register as an attendee for the virtual summit, you will be sent an email with links for each session. Once you register at the session link, you will be able to join in-person. You **must** use the same email address you used to register as an attendee to gain access to the training sessions.

### Can I share my session link?

Everyone who joins a session will be approved to enter the session once registration has been verified. You will not be able to share a session link with a second person.
